Recruitment of Apprentices

The PA Practitioner's Programme will only commence with a minimum of two Apprentices.

The Professional Astrologer's Programme (extended modules) will only commence with a minimum of two Apprentices.

All Apprentices must purchase the current Solar Fire software, if haven't previously bought.

- 3) Consultation Practicum & the 'Talking Cure' Dialogue Method
- 4) Relationship & Predictive Astrology
- 5) Marketing & Sustaining a Professional Practice

All Apprentices (from both Programmes) must complete this syllabus.

Apprentices from the PA Practitioner's Programme will graduate after completing these modules.

Apprentices from the Professional Astrologer's Programme will go on to the extended modules, covering:

- 2) Traditional Astrology & Horary
- 3) Advanced Techniques: Solar Return, Astro*Cartography, Declination, Asteroids and the Vertex
- 4) Elections (Date Selection) + Practicum
- 5) Rectification (Chart Correction) + Practicum
